- The recognition of the parties concerned with road safety
- The identification, analysis and assessment of risks
- The definition of road safety performance factors (risk exposure, intermediate and final) with the appropriate establishment of quantitative targets and related monitoring indicators reflecting them
- The establishment of action plans (improvement programmes) to systematically measure, monitor, analyze and evaluate the degree of achievement of the intermediate performance targets of the Road Safety Policy
- The continuous & excellent training of its staff

This Road Safety Policy and the associated aims and objectives (interim and final) are re-evaluated and revised by management, at least during the review of the road safety management system.
